# What is MTSS?

- Dr. Storm presented she is MLL and Co-lead for MTSS
  - MTSS is a multi-tiered framework of supports for students
    - Tiers are based on academics and behaviors
      - Tier 1- Everyone gets this support
      - Tier 2- Student needs more support
      - Tier 3- Most intense support offered to students
  - MTSS Behavior is PAWS
    - Goals of PAWS are:
      - Create a safe and caring learning environment
      - Social, Emotional and academic environments are supported
      - Includes all students at all time

- PAWS are used to reinforce behaviors:
  - Teachers use them to teach expected behaviors
  - Teachers show and reinforce behaviors daily
  - Students earn PAWS:
    - Class PAWS-the whole class worked well together or preformed the expected behaviors
    - Individual PAWS-students earn these by performing the expected behaviors at any time
  - All staff can give PAWS at any time
  - Every month there is a "big" ticket item or event for the students to spend their PAWS on
  - Teachers can have class incentives as well
  - PAWS cart is comes around quarterly for the students to use their paws on
  - Twice a year there are festivals for the students to attend using their PAWS
    - Fall Festival and Spring Festival
