- Choice opens November 6, 2023 closes January 10, 2023
 - Select 3 schools to apply to in rank order
 - If you get your first choice you must opt in, if you say no because you really wanted your second choice you will not get on the waitlist for the second one and you will not be choiced into any school.
 - Do not list feeder school- if you do not choice into any school you will go to Stanton Middle (feeder school)
- February 29th is the final day for notifications about choice selections
- March 15th deadline to accept or reject choice options
- Some schools have auditions or interviews
 - Cab Calloway has an audition
 - o If you have to audition you can pick 2 disciplines to audition for
 - Conrad you must interview for
 - If you have good Math and Science grades in 4th grade and the 1st quarter of the 5th grade you will not have to interview and will be automatically put into the lottery
- Living in Red Clay will give you a better chance to get into Red Clay schools
- Siblings in the school this year and next year will also give you a better chance to get into the school
